Anything else I should know?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Although Wyoming has no statute of limitations for any criminal offense, due process concerns may arise when delay in bringing charges results in prejudice to a defendant. In such cases, the charges may be dismissed if the defendant demonstrates that a pre-indictment delay causes substantial prejudice to his or her right to a fair trial and that the delay was intentional to gain a tactical advantage. <i>Phillips v. State</i>, 835 P.2d 1062, 1069 (Wyo. 1992).
